1. What is Safari Kid Math bowl about?  
It's a math tournament consisting of two rounds, One Team event and other Individual event. The main goal of this tournament is to encourage the kids to solve challenging math problems.
2. Who runs this tournament?  
Safari Kid along with the High school kids lead, run and support this tournament. The whole event is an AID (Association for India's Development) fundraiser.
3. Do all proceeds go as fundraising?  
Yes, other than the costs that are involved in running this event everything will be donated.
4. How much is the registration cost?  
Registration fee is \$99 for each team.
5. How to Register?  
You can register Online or send us the Check or Money Order.

6. How many kids can form a team?  
Team can form with a minimum of 3 kids to a maximum of 5 kids.
7. Who can form a team?  
Kids from the any school can form a team with the help of a parent coach.
8. Does the team need to register through school only?  
No, Any parent can form a team.
9. Do the teams have a name?  
Kids can come up with a team name during registration otherwise school name will become the team name.  
Example: McNair elementary has 3 teams. Teams are named as McNair ES 1, McNair ES 2 etc.



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### 10. How are the teams divided?

In the group of 5 kids the highest grade will represent the team level.

For example: Team of 5 kids has FOUR 4th graders and ONE 6<sup>th</sup> grader. The team will be representing Grade 6.

### 11. Are there only team level awards?

There will be team level and Grade level awards.

Grade 4-6 team level awards, Grade 4 /Grade 5/ Grade 6 will have grade level awards.

Our goal is to encourage kids and nurture their talent.

### 12. How the team and individual rounds are different?

- In the team event, Team will come up with a common solution to the given 10 questions. Time limit is 20 minutes.
- In individual event each participant of the team will solve 10 questions. Time limit is 30 Minutes.

Team score is based on both the team and individual scores.

### 13. What happens if there is a Tie?

There will be a tie breaker event.

### 14. When are the results declared?

All the results are declared on the same day and awards are given at the end of the day. All the details will be given during the registration.

### 15. Can students test down to a class they have already completed? Can they test up to a higher class?

Students will not be allowed to participate in a grade lower than what they are currently. However, kids can always participate in higher grade.

Example: Grade 3 kids who are really interested in challenge math can compete in a Grade 4 team.



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16. Can a student register in two teams?

No student will be allowed to participate in two teams. Double registration is not allowed.

17. Can I cancel my registration because of conflicts?

Registration fee is nonrefundable. Please double check before registering

18. Can the kids switch teams after registration?

Not ideally. Logistically it will be very hard to organize the changes.

19. When and where is the contest?

Safari Kid Math Bowl is on April 18<sup>th</sup> 2015.
